**WHO GOES TO CUB CAMP?** Any youth, whether registered in Cub Scouts or not, entering grades 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 in the fall of 2023 are eligible to attend. Parents are needed to volunteer during camp to ensure that one adult is present for every 5 youth in attendance. Parents may volunteer as chaperones or camp staff. (Youth who will be first graders in the fall require daily attendance of a parent or guardian).

**CUB CAMP IS A VALUABLE ACTIVITY FOR MANY REASONS.** It helps Packs succeed. It strengthens the den. It provides continuation of the Cub Scout program during the summer and the opportunity for Scouts and their Packs to earn awards. It promotes FUN and adventure with a purpose.
